What we are looking to find out is why you want to attend PitR and why you believe you are a good candidate. All successful applicants receive scholarships covering the entire cost of the program including eleven nights accommodation, three meals per day, local transportation and organized excursions but excluding transportation to and from Calgary. All applicants will be notified about the decision by the end of May, 2014.
